STUDENT COMMITMENT

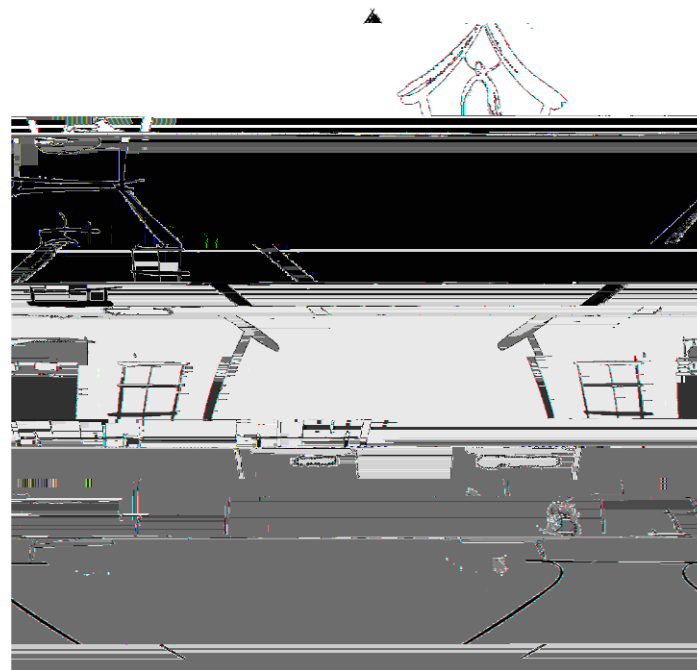
I realize that my education is important. I know that I am responsible for my own success. Therefore, I agree to carry out the following responsibilities to the best of my ability:

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What is the Title I program?

Title I is part of the federal Every Student Succeeds Act [ESSA]. Title I funds are used to provide instructional support for those children who have trouble with reading and mathematics. Money is allocated by the federal government and distributed to the Central Bucks School District by the Pennsylvania Department of Education. The amount of money each school receives is based on the number of children eligible for free and reduced lunch programs.

What kind of Title I instructional support is provided in my child's school?

Students identified for the Title I program receive help specific to their individual need to enable them to improve academic performance and meet state and district proficiency standards. At John Barclay, Title 1 instruction is provided by Reading Specialists, RtI teachers and Instructional Assistants. Reading and math support may be provided by Instructional Assistants or RtI teachers; this support may be provided either in small groups or on an individual basis. All the Instructional Assistants working with students in the Title I program meet the requirements specified in the ESSA Act and are highly qualified. Central Bucks is very fortunate to have these highly qualified assistants who have student success as their main goal.

How are children selected for the Title I program?

At the end of the school year, classroom teachers and Reading Specialists identify students who would benefit from the additional support of the Title I
